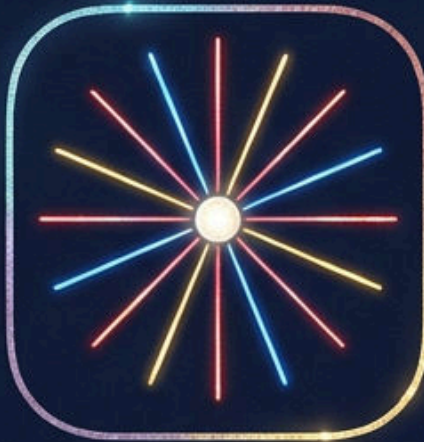


How to Draw Fireworks

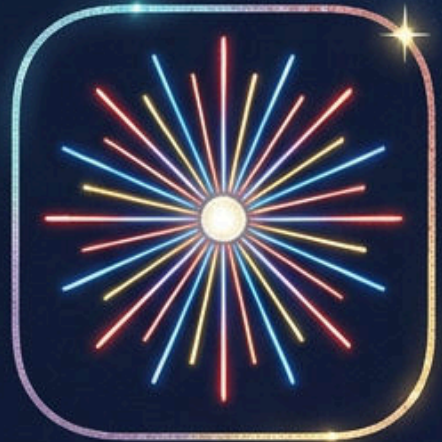
Celebration bursts in 5 steps



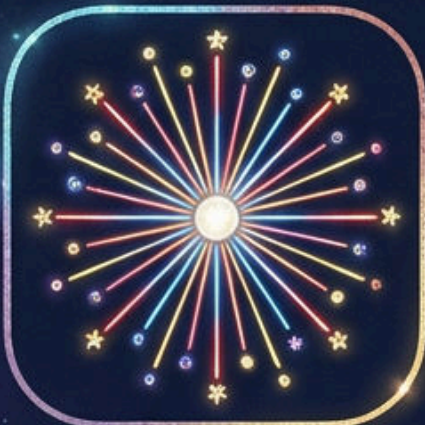
Step 1: Draw a small circle for the firework center



Step 2: Draw lines radiating out from center in all directions



Step 3: Add shorter lines between the main rays



Step 4: Add small sparkle dots or stars at each line tip



Step 5: Draw multiple fireworks at different sizes, add sparkle trails

Firework Patterns



Starburst: Classic radiating lines (what we drew)

Weeping Willow: Lines that curve downward



Palm Tree: Lines shoot up then cascade down



Peony: Round cluster with trailing sparks

Tips

- Start from center point and burst outward
- Lines radiate in all directions like an explosion
- Vary line lengths for natural look
- Add dots/stars at line tips for sparkles
- Draw multiple fireworks at different stages
- Some bursts large, some small
- Add trailing sparkles falling down
- Use different colors for each burst

Fireworks bring New Year's celebration, July 4th magic, and explosive joy!
