

How to Draw a Cat Face


Purr-fect in 6 easy steps




Step 1: Draw a circle for the head




Step 2: Add two triangle ears at the top




Step 3: Draw light guidelines to place features



Step 4: Add big oval eyes, triangle nose, curved mouth



Step 5: Add pupils, inner ears, and whisker dots



Step 6: Draw whiskers, add fur detail and shading

Tips Box

- Cats have large eyes relative to face
- Nose is small and centered
- Whiskers come from the cheek area
- Ears can point different directions for personality
- Add fur texture with short strokes

Every cat has personality - experiment with eye shapes and ear positions!
