


How to Use These Templates

1. Download and print your chosen template on cardstock or heavy paper for durability.
2. Use a sharp craft knife or scissors to carefully cut out the main template shape.
3. Place the template onto your desired art surface (e.g., watercolor paper, canvas, or fabric).
4. Secure the template with low-tack tape to prevent shifting during tracing.
5. Trace around the inside and outside edges of the template with a pencil or fine-point marker.
6. For detailed designs, consider using a stencil brush with acrylic paint or ink to fill in the pattern.
7. Alternatively, use colored pencils, markers, or pastels to color within the traced lines.
8. Experiment with layering different templates to create unique compositions and textures.
9. If using multiple colors, allow each layer to dry completely before adding the next.
10. Once finished, carefully remove the template and tape, and display your unique artwork!


