2. Start with lots of water.

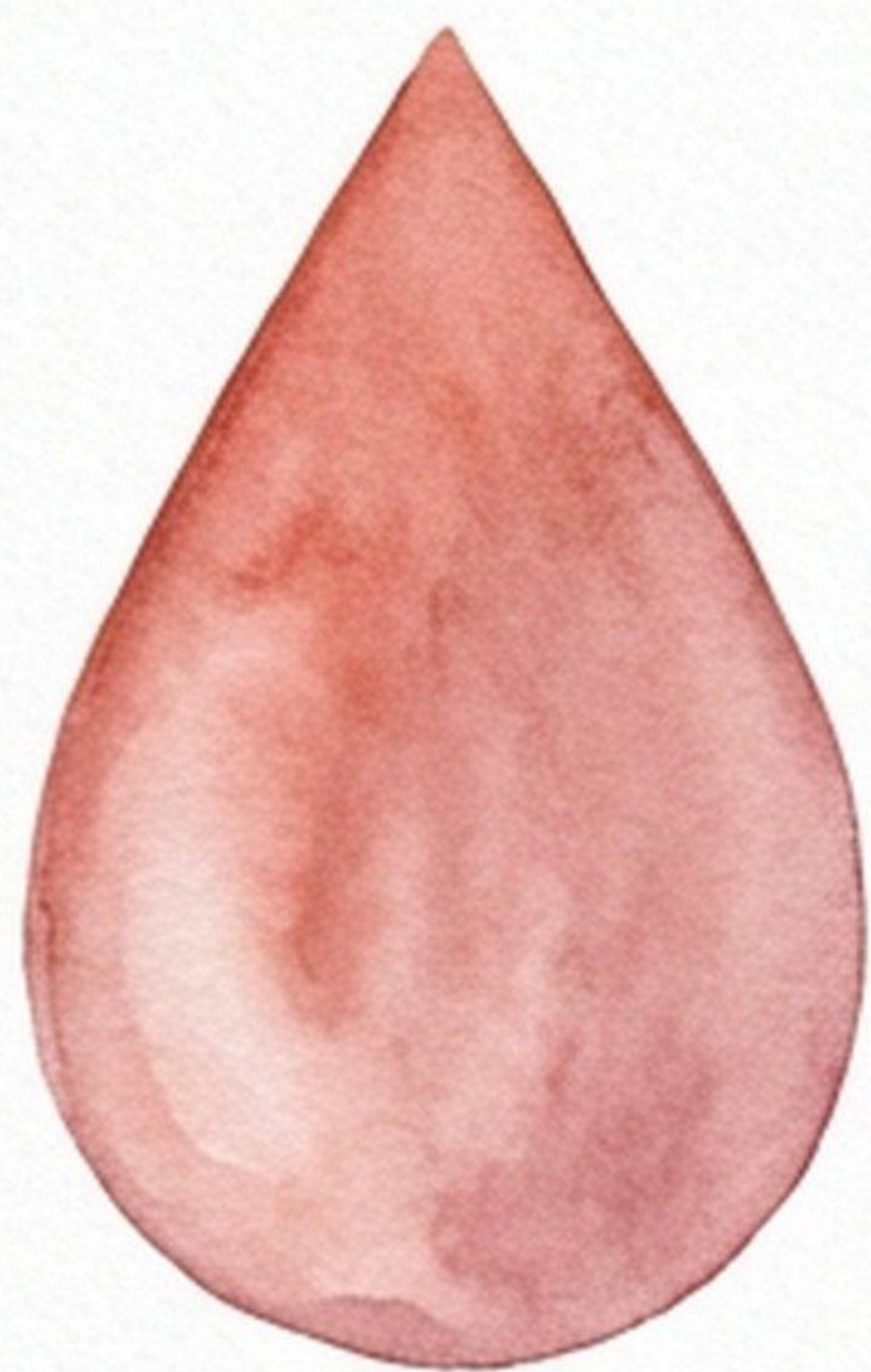


3. Let colors bleed naturally.



4. Embrace imperfection.

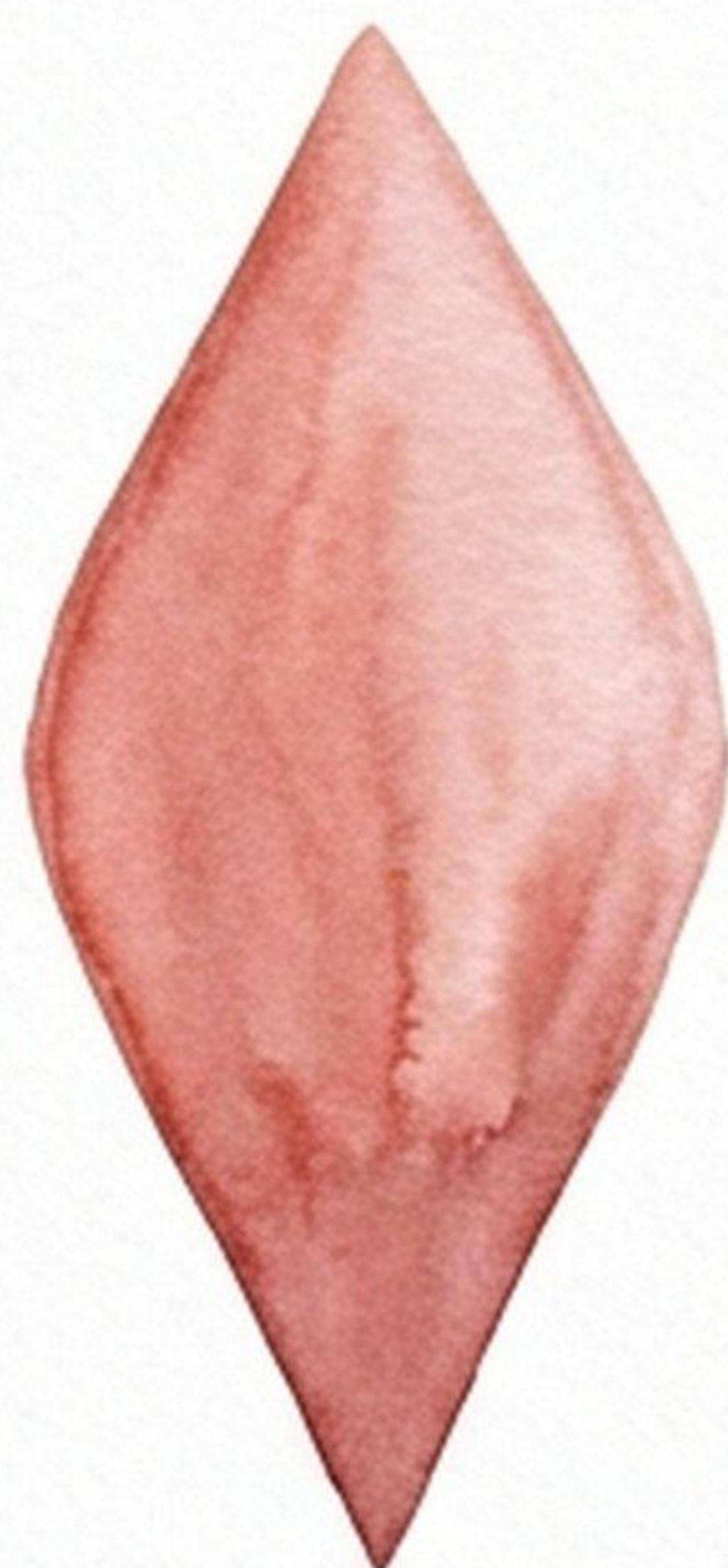

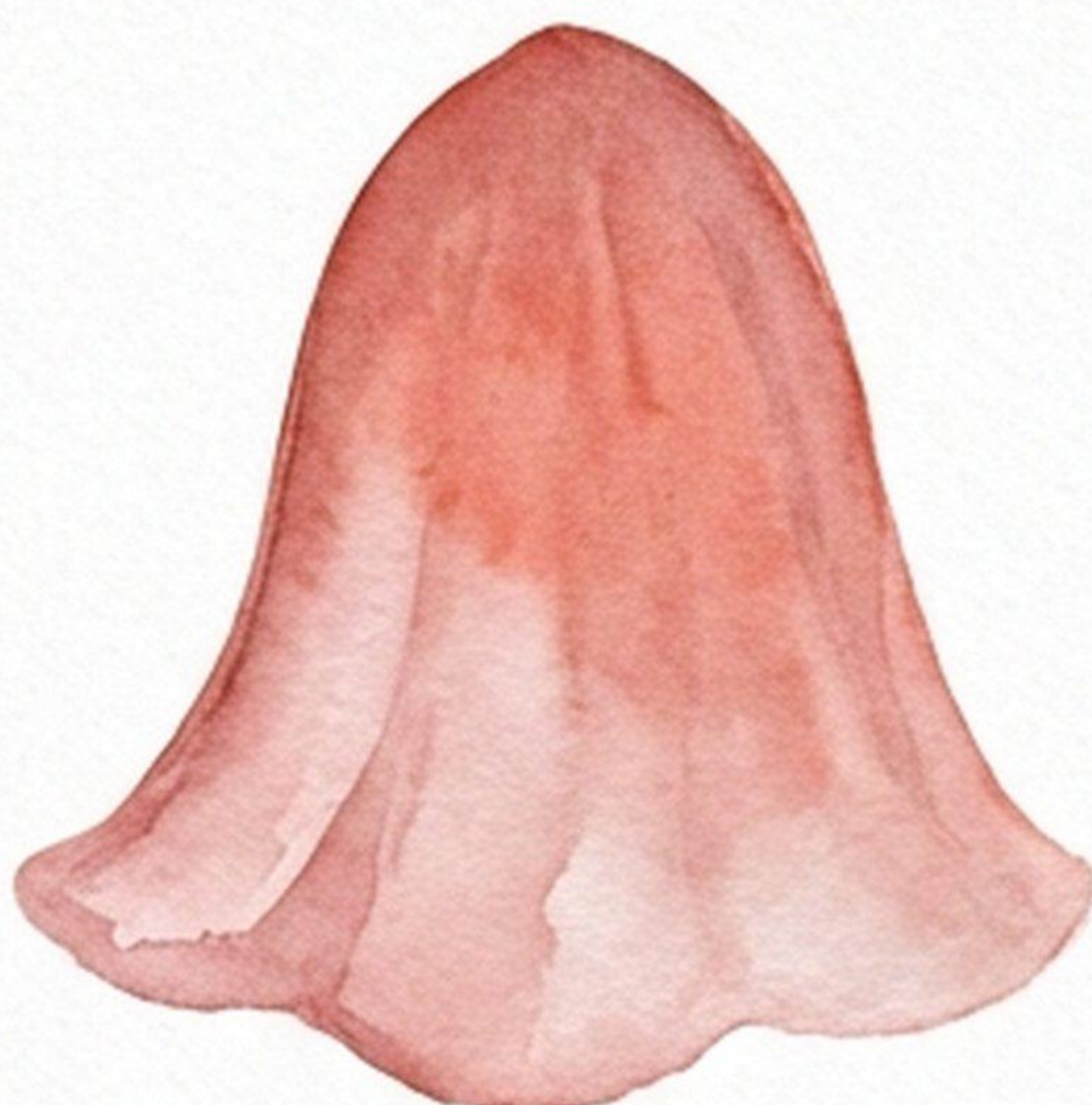

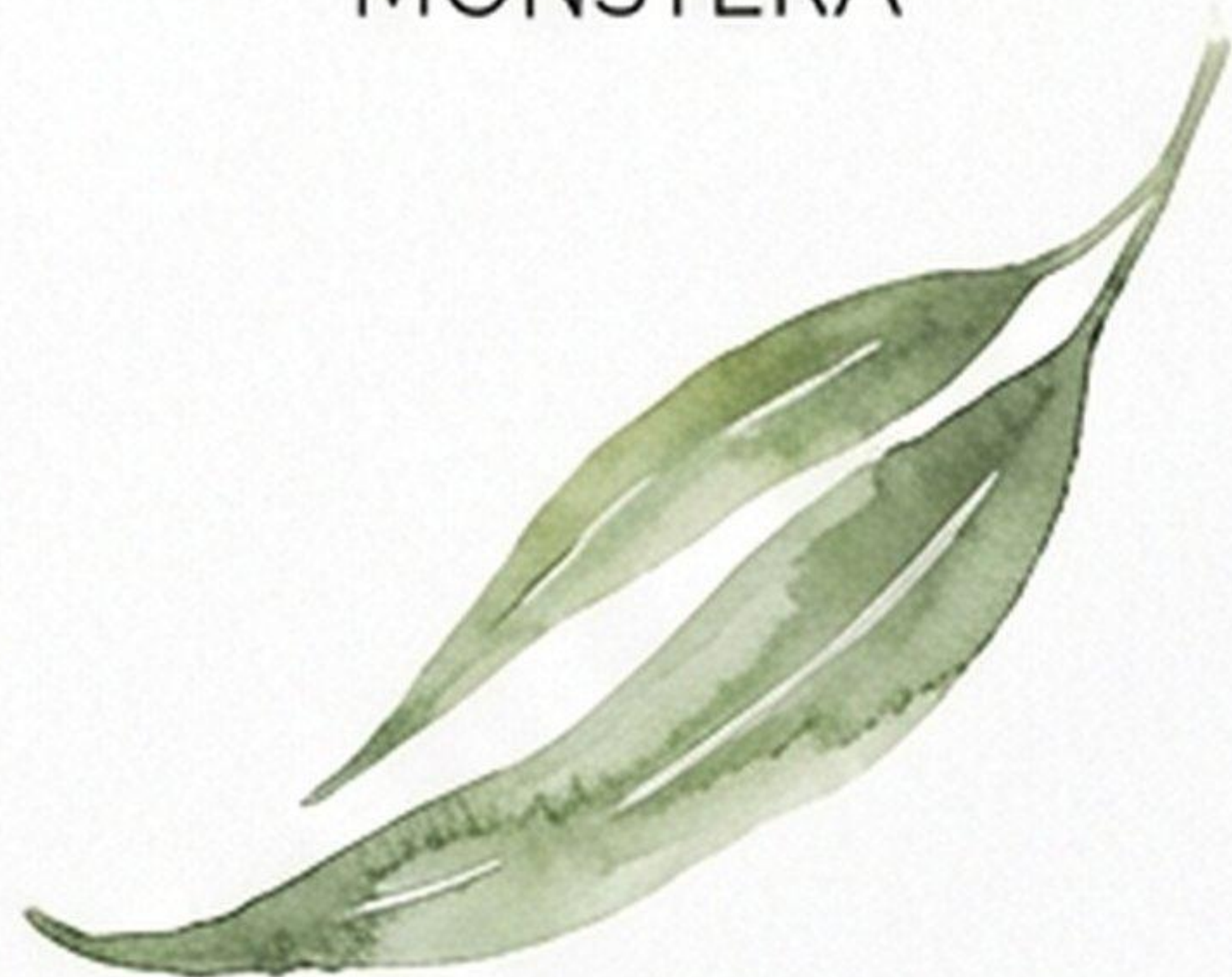
