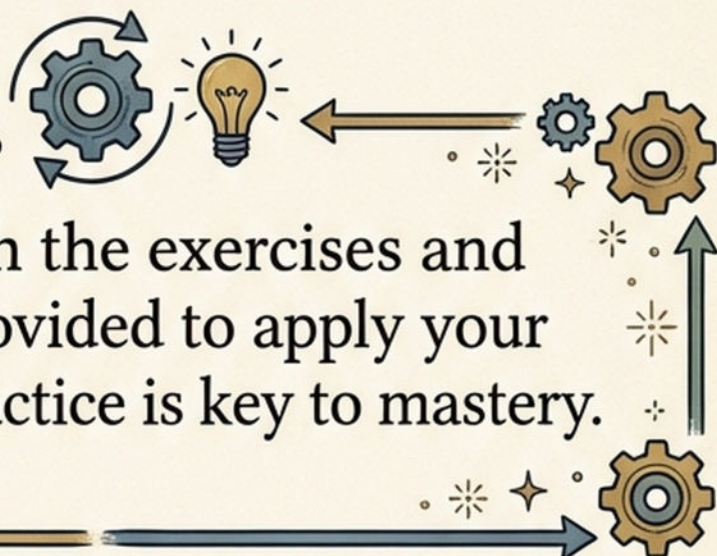

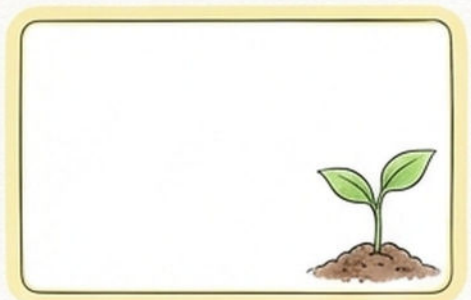

Illustrate a scene featuring rain, puddles, and reflections, perhaps with an umbrella.



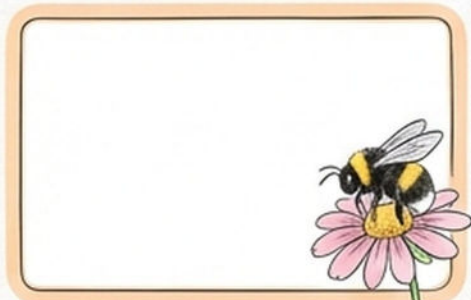
Thu, April 14: Green Shoots.
