3



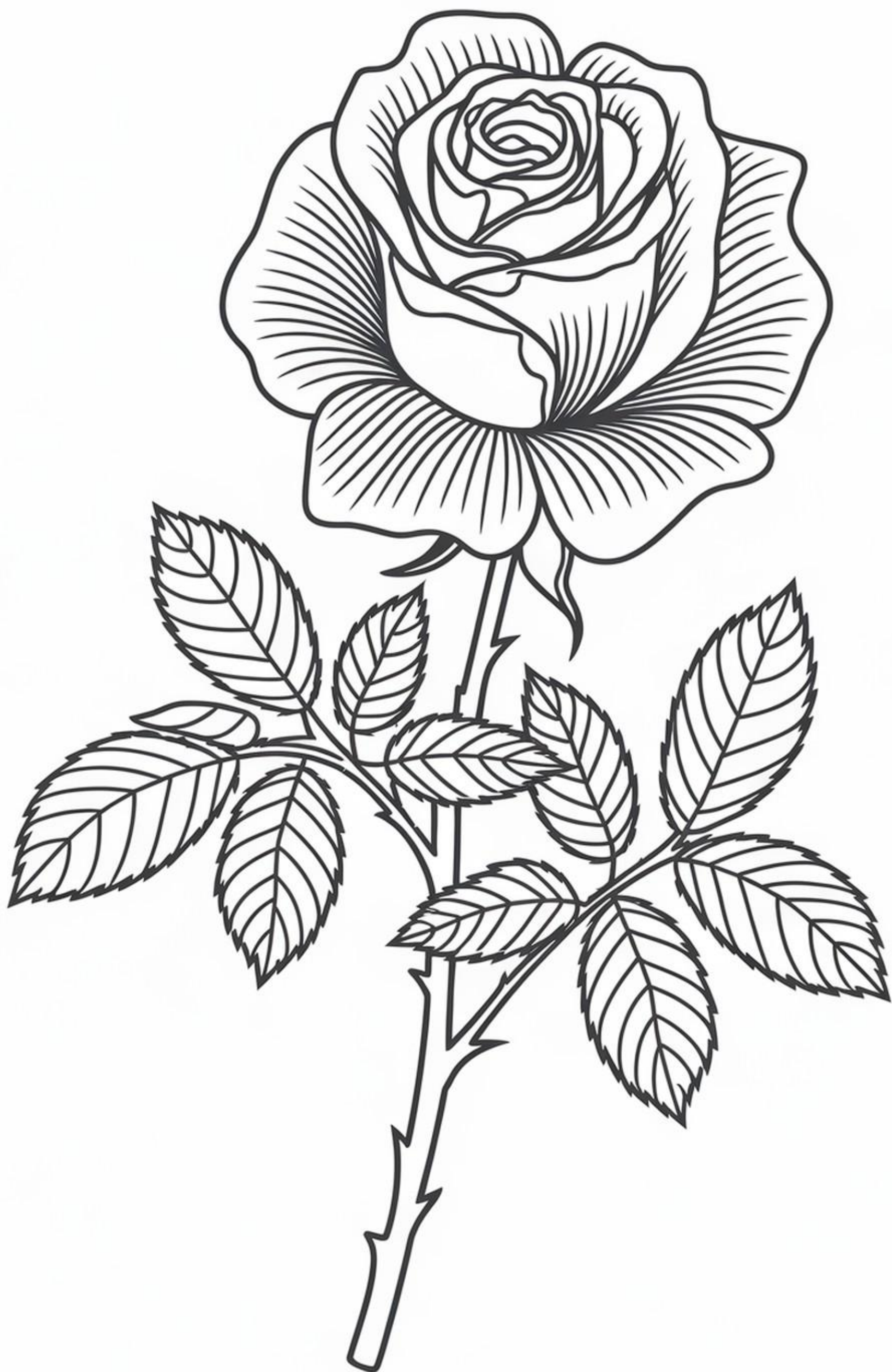
Add watercolor or acrylic paint

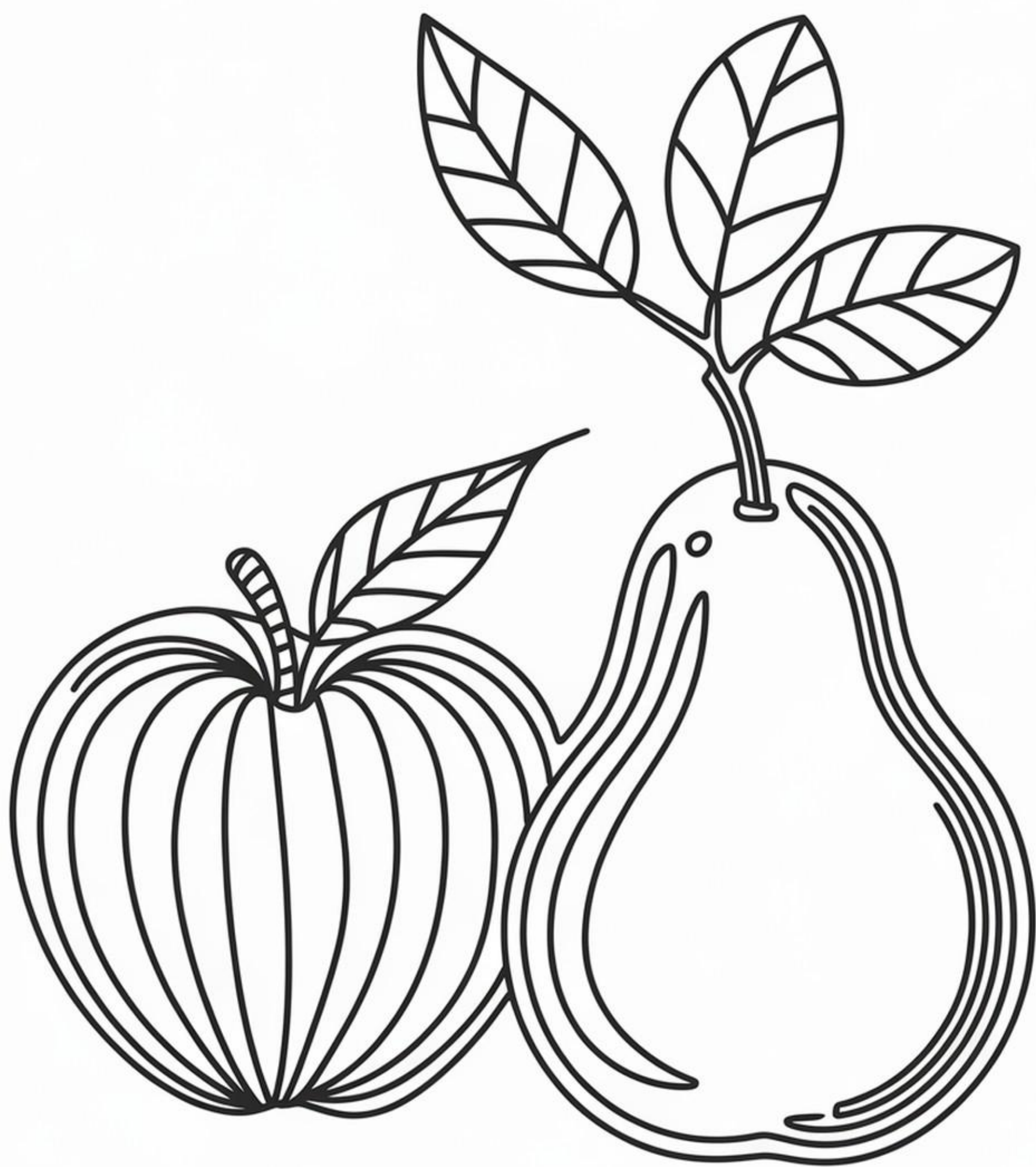


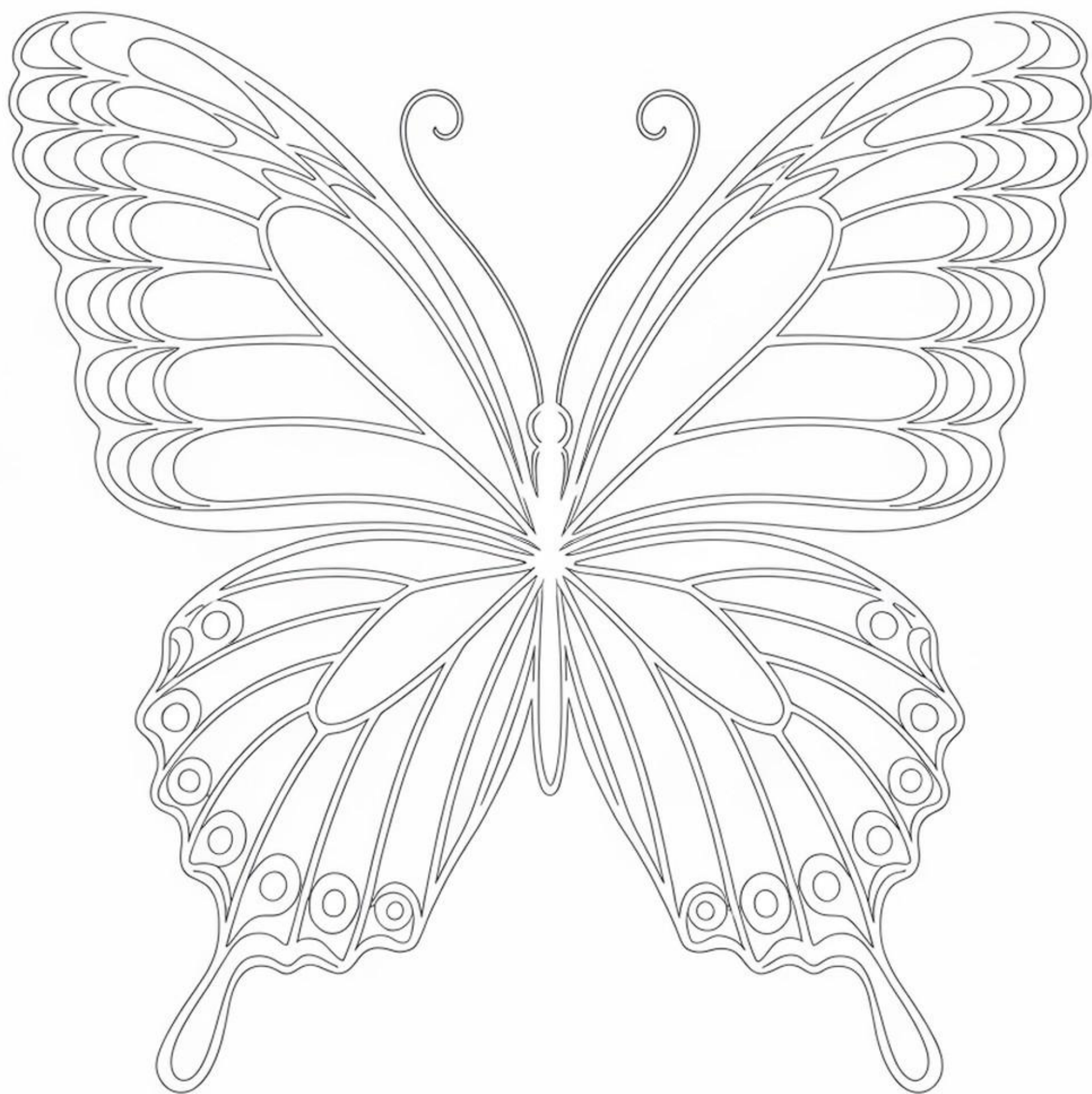


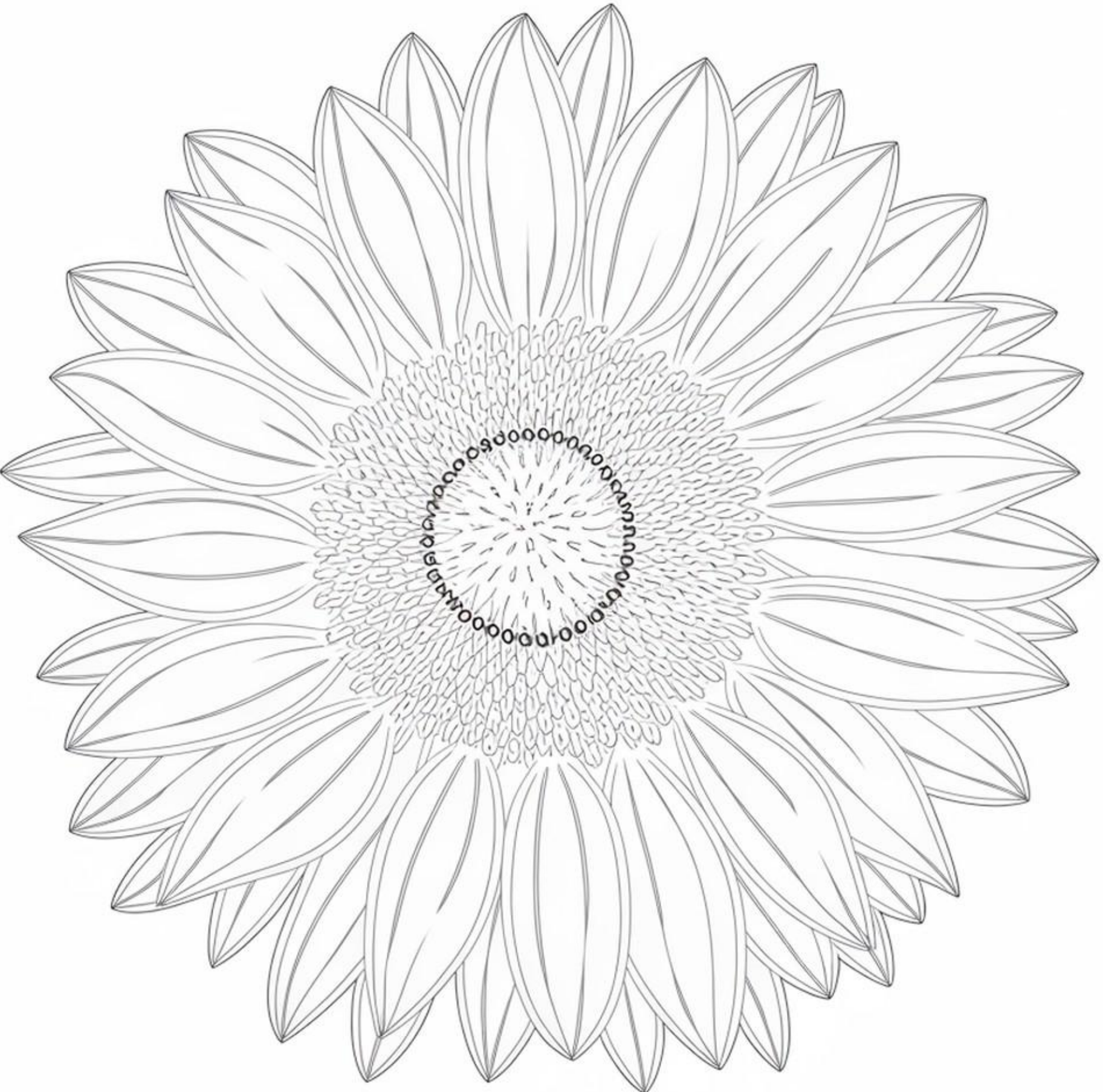




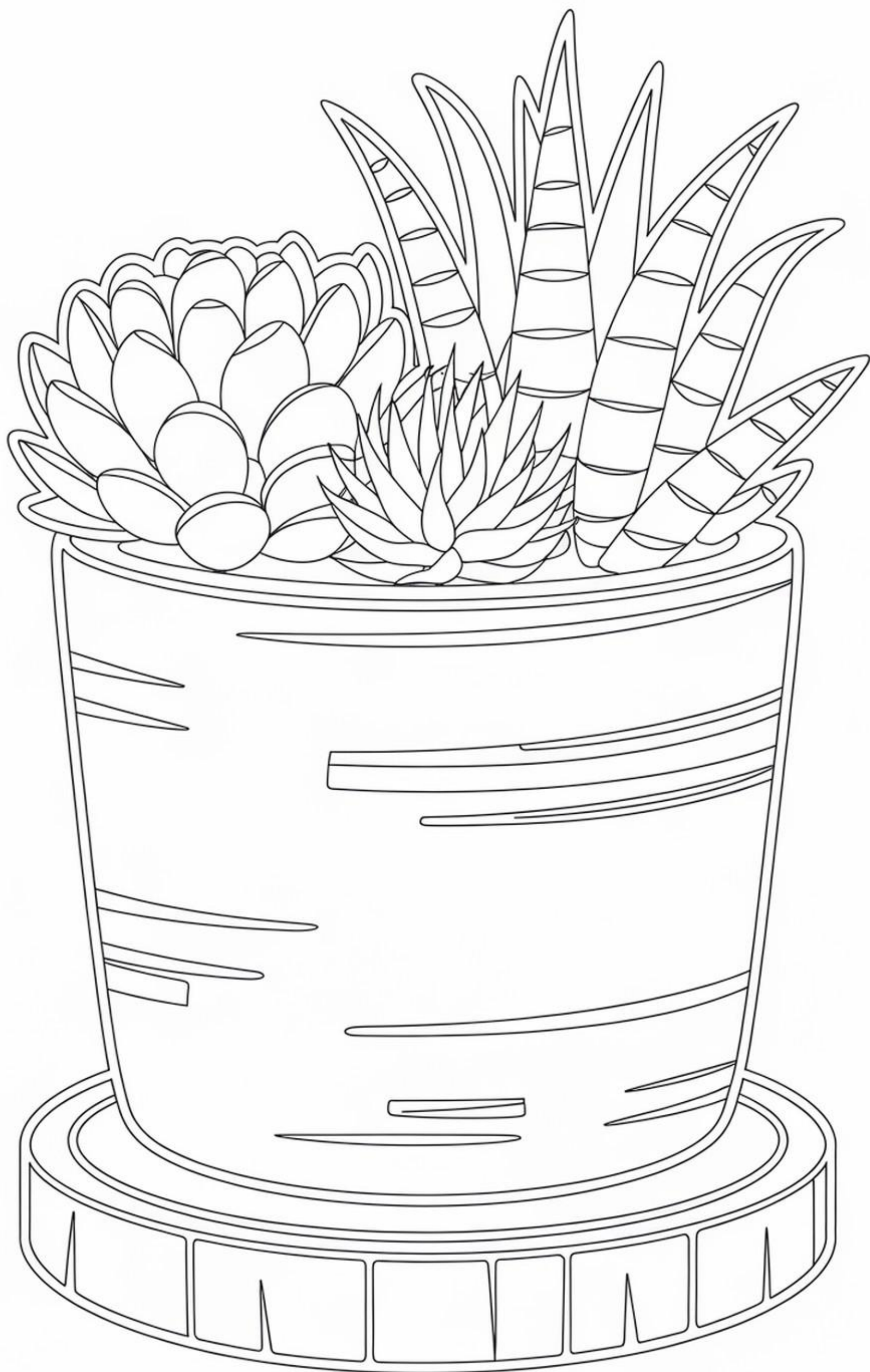


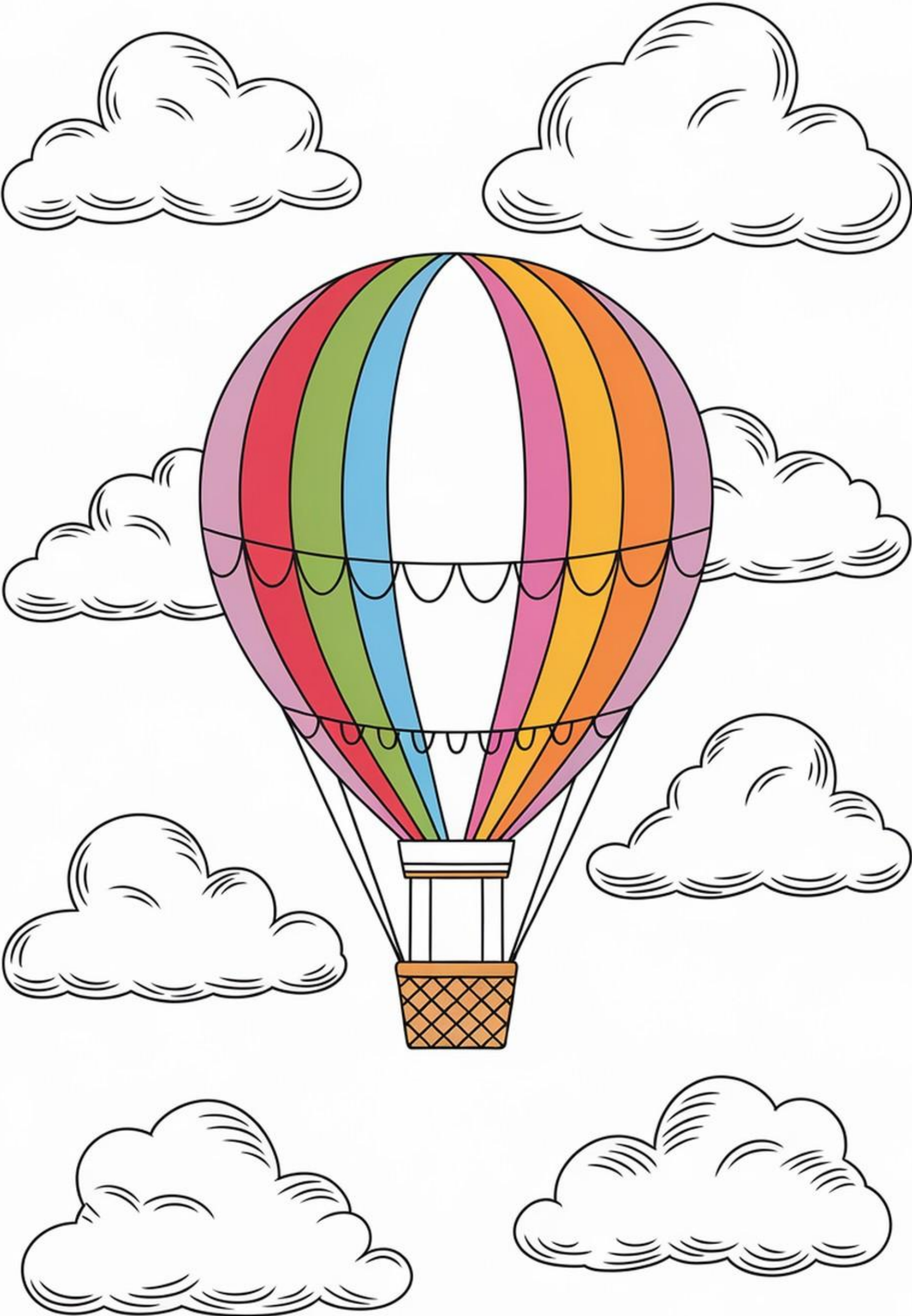












Painting Tips for Beginners



- Start with *light washes*, build up color.



- Let each *layer dry* completely.



- Use *less water* for more control.



- Embrace *happy accidents*.



- *Practice* makes progress!



Recommended Supplies



- **Watercolor paper (cold press, 140lb+)**
Essential for wet-on-wet techniques; the textured surface (cold press) handles water well without buckling, and the weight (140lb or higher) ensures durability and prevents warping.



- **Student-grade watercolors**
Affordable and vibrant pigment sets perfect for beginners; they offer good color payoff and are easy to mix, allowing for experimentation without a large investment.



- **Round brushes (sizes 4, 8, 12)**
Versatile brush shapes for varied strokes; size 4 for fine details, size 8 for general painting, and size 12 for larger washes and filling backgrounds.



- **Water container and paper towels**
A sturdy container for rinsing brushes and fresh water; paper towels are crucial for blotting excess water, correcting mistakes, and cleaning brushes effectively.
