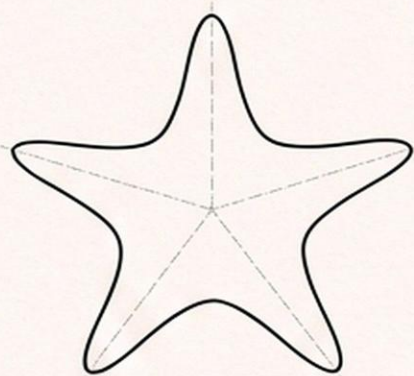
How to Draw a Starfish

1. Draw star shape



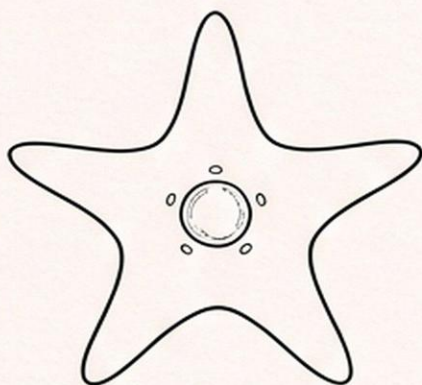
Start with a simple 5-pointed star guide.

2. Add curved arms



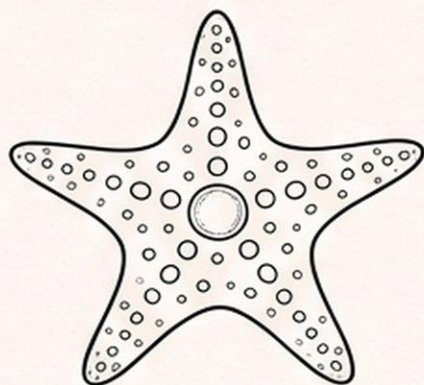
Round out the points to create the arms.

3. Draw center



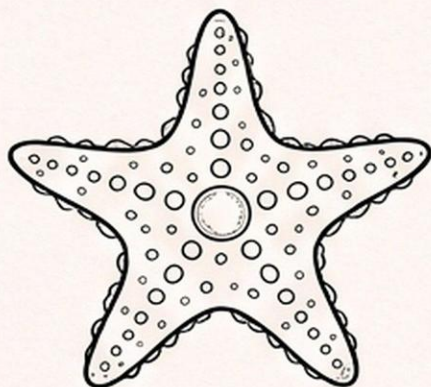
Add the central disc and small mouth detail.

4. Add bumpy texture



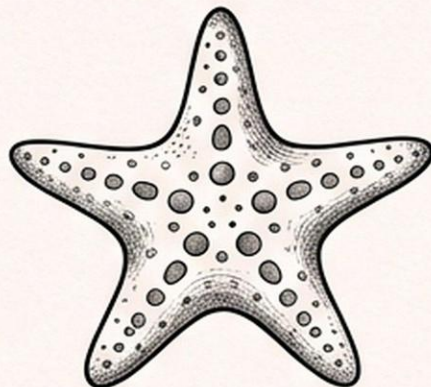
Sketch small bumps over the entire surface.

6. Add spots and shading

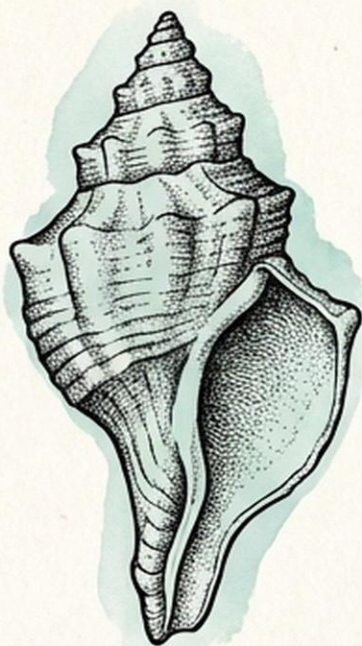


Finish with spots, dots, and soft shading for depth.
